Dear Parents,

Due to the growing popularity of the Summer Camp program and an increase in the number of families that are served by the Perry County Board of Developmental Disabilities, we have had a dramatic increase in the number of families interested in Summer Camp for their child. Due to these factors there will be a limited number of spots available, **we will only accept the first 25 applications.**

Since there is a great deal of planning that goes into the Summer Camp program, there will be a cut off date for camp applications. Enclosed you will find the Summer Camp application. **We are requiring you to fill out and return the application, and a copy of your child's IEP from school by March 1 or your child will not be able to attend camp this year. We will not accept any late applications.**

Again this year, the Perry County Board of Developmental Disabilities is requiring that you attend the 'Parents Informational Meeting' prior to Summer Camp that will inform you about what we will be doing during camp, fill out any additional paperwork, as well as having the opportunity to meet some of the staff. This meeting will be scheduled sometime before June and I will send out a date and time later.
